

# Invitation to Bid (IFB)

1. The Government of Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has received financing from International Development Association (IDA) (the 'Bank') in the form of a 'Credit' toward the cost of One WASH National Program -Consolidated WASH account Phase-II (OWNP-CWA-II) and intends to apply parts of the proceeds of this Loan to eligible payments under the contract for the implementation of three Production Wells Drilling, Construction & Pumping Tests at Kusaye Beru (2) and Kara Gora sites in Kersa District, Jimma Zone of Oromia Region Water Supply Project.
2. The Ministry of Water and Energy (MoWE) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for drilling works of three Production Wells Drilling, Construction & Pumping Tests at Kusaye Beru (2) and Kara Gora sites in Kersa District, Jimma Zone of Oromia Region. The detail description of work is described in Table below:

Bidders shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following requirement(s):

3. The Bidder has successfully participated as contractor or subcontractor in at least 1 (one) contracts within the last 10 (ten) years, with a value of 90 million ETB and above with a similar size, nature, complexity, and scope of drilling works that have been successfully and substantially completed and similar size to the proposed drilling works. The contract performed should be supported by the name and addresses of the clients. For contractors who executed the drilling works in separate two contracts 45 million ETB or more for each drilling work contracts are required Ongoing projects considered for satisfactory execution of contract must be at least 70% completed.
4. The bidder shall demonstrate that it has access to, or has available liquid asset, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit and other financial means (independent of any contractual advance payment sufficient to meet the cash flow requirements of 18 million ETB.
5. The Audited financial statements or others financial statement acceptable to the Employer for the last 5(five) years (2019-2023) shall be submitted and must demonstrate the current soundness of the bidder's financial position and indicate its prospective long term profitability



6. The minimum Peak Annual Turnover of 72 million ETB calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed or audited financial statements by certified auditor or audited financial statements certified by Revenue Authority within the last 5 (five) years must be of or equivalent.
7. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures as specified in the World Bank Procurement regulation for IPF borrowers procurement in investment project financing GOODS, Works, non-consulting and consulting service fifth edition September 2023 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the procurement regulation. In addition, please refer to paragraph 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth in the World Bank policy on conflict of interest.
8. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from Ministry of Water & Energy, and inspect the bidding documents during office hours 8:30 A.M. to 12:30 PM in the morning and 1:30 PM to 5:30 P.M. in the afternoon at the address given below.
9. A scanned copy of the bidding document in English can be obtained free of charge by downloading it from the ministry of water and energy website <http://www.mowe.gov.et/en/tenders>. Bidders are required to complete the registration form of bidders issued the bid in sending the representative to the Ministry of Water and Energy in person during the office working days and time in the Room 112 of the first floor of the building before the deadline of submission of the bid. It is the responsibility of the bidder to follow, download and consider any amendment made to the bid document.
10. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **July 29, 2024 at 3:00 PM**. late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on **July 29, 2024 at 3:30 PM**.
11. All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security of **ETB 500,000.00 (Five hundred thousand)** in the form of unconditional Bank Guarantee or CPO. The bid security shall be valid for 118 (one hundred eighteen) days. The Bid Security of a Joint Venture shall be issued in the name of the Joint Venture submitting the bid provided the Joint Venture has legally been constituted, or else it shall be issued in the name of all partners proposed for the Joint Venture in the bid.
